- 6% of general fund income for benevolence to Minneapolis Area Synod amounted to \$3,660.00.
- Xcel bill for fuel and electricity amounted to \$2,562.00 (up about \$1,250.00 from November).
- \$2,336.00 was paid from memorial money for the final payment of the dishwasher.

- Hail damage (2019) receipts were received in the amount of \$13,042.24.
- Payment using hail receipts in the amount of \$9,991.06 was paid for gutter, soffit and other roof repairs.
- Special gifts were given to the food shelf, Love INC and the Royals Room.
- Mortgage payments of \$5,000.00 continues to be paid.
